Can you tell us a little bit about your background and how Caddyshack was started?

Doug and Clay began to use carbon monoxide machines on their own fields and really liked the results, which led them to the idea for a new business venture. In 2016 I was asked to join the team and saw a great opportunity for the company and myself. As we sit today we have 30 machines running from Stockton down to Bakersfield. Our growth is a direct testament to our forward thinking team and the hard work that has been put into this company.

Tell us a little bit more about Caddyshack and what sets you apart from competitors?
Caddyshack Rodent Control is the biggest agriculture based rodent control company in the sate. With 30 plus rigs we are able to handle any job from small to big. With labor costs on the rise, the average farmer can't justify having full time employees look after their rodent issues. With our trained employees we can handle the job from start to finish, set up a schedule for follow up treatments and make sure growers rodent problems stay under control. Caddyshack is fully licensed and legal with every county in the Central Valley and more. With California pesticide rules getting stricter and stricter, growers are having issues using certain products. With Caddyshack there are no used reports, no restricted materials and no re-entry period.
